

## On-Line Blended Training Description

Blended training combines self-paced multi-media online training modules for the cognitive portion of CPR and First Aid, with traditional instructor-led classroom instruction for the hands-on portions.

## **PRICING**

- \$75.00 set-up fee, to become a Blended Training supplier for ATEM. This is a one-time setup fee, until the new guidelines change, and is required.
- \$50.00 to include your logo on each blended training exam. One-time setup fee, this is optional.
- \$5.00 fee for each student that successfully completes the blended portion.
  - At the end of each month your organization will be billed for the number of people that successfully passed the cognitive portion. This fee is \$5.00 per student, and not dependent on the type of class they took. IE: If they took Adult/AED/BBP the fee is \$5.00. If they took Adult CPR the fee is \$5.00. If your student took Adult CPR and later decided to take First Aid, each class would be \$5.00.
  - Please note: the student taking the training does NOT pay the \$5.00 fee. You will give them your Training Center's passcode, which will allow them online access. At the end of the month, your training facility will be billed per student usage.

Your Blended Training class will reduce training time and costs.

- The computer portion can be completed from any Internet-accessible computer, 24-hours a day, which allows • greater flexibility for the student's cognitive training sessions.
- Student time varies depending on their previous knowledge of CPR.
- The hands-on skills testing is shorter and easier to schedule, reducing employee downtime and possible • overtime pay or replacement employees.

## How it works:









- $\Rightarrow$  Schedule the training program of your choice, give students one month to access the on-line portion, and complete the program. Remediation is allowed and encouraged; students can take the cognitive portion of the class as many times as necessary to successfully complete the program, for one flat price.
- $\Rightarrow$  You will receive access codes for the students to log-on and complete the cognitive portion. At the successful completion, they will receive a document which is required to bring to class.
- $\Rightarrow$  A professional CPR/FA instructor will come onsite and conduct the hands-on portion
- $\Rightarrow$  It's that easy! After the hands-on portion, students will receive their 2-year certification card. (Note: BBP/ABP certification is only for 1-year.)
